

Draft Al-Madinah School Enrolment Scheme

A) Al-Madinah School is an integrated school with a Muslim special character. Therefore, priority will be given to students, who identify as Muslim in accordance to the special character of the school. However, the number of places available for will be governed by the maximum number allowable from time to time under the School's Integration Agreement.

B) If the total number of applications are less than the number of places available, then all applicants will be enrolled.

C) If there are more applications than available places, then applicants will be enrolled according to the following order of priorities:

- 1) Those who are siblings of current students;
- 2) Those who are sons or daughters of present members of the Al-Madinah School staff, School Board or Proprietors. Staff members must be permanent employees of the school.
- 3) Those who are siblings or children of former students;

D) If at any level of this classification there are more applicants than available places, those applicants who live closest to the school will be enrolled until all of the available places have been filled. "Closest" shall be defined as "measured by the most direct driving distance from the applicant's principal residence to the main vehicle entrance of Al-Madinah School".

E) Non-Preference Applicants (non-special character) will only be enrolled if enrolment places remain after all Preference Applicants have been enrolled and the School Board judges that enrolment of the Non-Preference Applicants will not compromise its ability to offer places to Preference Applicants who may apply for enrolment at a later date.

F) Waiting List

If the total number of applications is greater than the number of places available, unsuccessful applicants will have their names recorded on a waiting list and shall be ranked in accordance with the criteria detailed above.

Those applicants on the waiting list may be offered places at a later date if places become available. The waiting list will remain current until the School Board next notifies the public that it is inviting applications for the next enrolment intake.
