Primary School includes students from Year 1 to 8 while Secondary School consists of students from Year 9 to 13: The following subjects are being taught school wide: Qur'aanic Studies which includes reading of Qur'aan Qaidah Lesson, 2nd Qaidah, Juz Amma and the recitation and memorisation of the entire Qur'aan.

NCEA Studies:

Year 11 to Year 13 students are doing Religious Studies through NCEA guidance and archive credits which are recognised as University Entrance credits. These credits eventually helps students in getting higher University Entrance credits and hence leads to higher University Entrance points.
