# **ASSESSMENT OUTLINE**

Y9 and 10 will have formative assessments on Formal Writing and Visual Language.

Y11 students will be working on AS
91926-Develop ideas in writing using stylistic
and written conventions. This is due in Term 3
Week 6. Students will also be preparing for AS
91925 Demonstrate understanding of specific
aspects of studied text, for external exams.

Y12 will work on submitting AS 91101 assessment in Term 3 week 3 and submit AS 91106 Form developed personal response in Term 3 Week 1. Students will work AS 91105 research and submit the draft for research in Term 3 week 8.

Y13 will work on **AS 91476** Create and deliver fluent and coherent oral text which develops, sustains, and structures ideas. This will be completed and recorded in **Term 3 in week 3**. Students will continue working on **AS 91479** Develop an informed understanding of literature and/or language using critical texts and submit the draft in **week 7 of Term 3**.

### **EXPECTATIONS**

The expectation in English is that all students will complete assigned tasks, come prepared everyday and meet assignment deadlines. Thorough revision and consistent effort is vital for external exams. Attendance during revision period for NCEA is critical to passing the external exams. It is very important that students utilise their time wisely in school and at home.
