PISA Test

Our school has been selected for an important international research study, PISA (Programme for International Student Assessment). Over 90 countries are participating in 2025 and a random sample of 6 300 fifteen-year-olds have been selected from approximately 200 schools. The Ministry of Education has randomly selected 27 students from Al-Madinah school.

PISA assesses students nearing the end of their compulsory education and is designed to evaluate how well students have developed the cumulative skills and knowledge they will need after they finish school, for success and informed citizenship in the modern world. PISA assesses three core areas of competence seen as providing a strong foundation for further and life long learning: reading literacy, mathematical literacy and scientific literacy.
