Career Pathways in Action

Work Ready Barista Course

Some students from years 11 and 12 have completed Work Ready Barista Course . This course has provided valuable practical skills and nationally recognised unit standards at Level 2. They students have learnt how to interact with customers in a service delivery context , apply safe work practices in the workplace and use commercial espresso coffee equipment to prepare espresso beverages under supervision.

Retail Course

A group of students are doing retail and are out on work placement once every week for 10 weeks. The programme is giving valuable work experience in retail and help students to move from school to career.
